<u>Definiton of Areas of Scholarship/Creative Endeavors</u>

In <u>Scholarship Reconsidered</u> (San Francisco: Jossey-Bass, 1990), Boyer and the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching, re-emphasizing that scholarship "is at the heart of what the profession is all about" (1), identify four basic types of separate but overlapping scholarship:

- 1. The Scholarship of Discovery
- 2. The Scholarship of Integration
- 3. The Scholarship of Application
- 4. The Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SOTL).

In addition, the University recognizes a fifth type of scholarship:

5. Creative Endeavor
