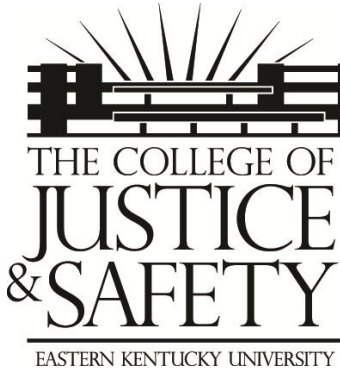
Simultaneous submissions are accepted, but please make us aware if your work is already copyrighted or under-consideration elsewhere.
