Nationally recognized authorities ranked the Easternites as the eleventh team in the nation in a list of more than 800 collegiate quintets at the close of the season.

The Maroons of Coach Paul McBrayer closed their season in grand fashion by winning the championship of the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament, one of the stiffest meets in the nation. The McBrayer men accomplished this by defeating both Western Kentucky and Marshall in one day.

On this memorable day, Eastern downed the Thundering Herd of Marshall by a 66-62 count in the afternoon. Several hours later, the Varsity copped its greatest victory of the year by whipping its arch rival, Western Kentucky, by a 62-50 romp.

During the regular campaign, Eastern defeated such powers as Bowling Green University of Ohio. Beloit College, Louisville, Evansville, Marshall and Dayton.
