Minutes of Board Meeting

The Board of Control of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association met at the Kentucky High School Athletic Association building, Lexington, on Friday afternoon, December 21, 1973. The meeting was called to order by President Frank Simpson at 1:30 P.M., with Board members J. C. Cantrell, J. Thomas Creamer, Howard R. Crittenden, Andrew J. Fultz, Arthur R. Hawkins, Louie Martin, W. P. Wheeler, James R. Williams, and Roy Winchester; Commissioner J. B. Mansfield and Assistant Commissioners Tom Mills, Louis Stout and Billy Wise. Mr. Wilbur Smith represented the State Department of Education. The invocation was given by J. C. Cantrell.

Roy Winchester moved, seconded by Jim Williams, that the reading of the minutes of the October meeting be waived since the members of the Board had received copies of these minutes. The motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Mansfield presented the following eligibility cases for Board consideration:

1. Mike Newsome and Larry Daugherty, students at McDowell High School who are ineligible under By-Law 6, Section 1, Transfer of First Team Competitor. Based on information presented by the principals of both schools involved, Louie Martin moved, seconded by J. C. Cantrell, that the eligibility of both students be restored. All members voted aye.

2. Barry Wayne Leach, a student at Ohio County High School, is ineligible under By-Law 5, Section 4, Preceding Semester Enrollment. Based upon information received from Prin. Shelby C. Forsythe, Jr. and a statement from the attending physician, W. P. Wheeler moved, seconded by Howard Crittenden, that the eligibility of this student be restored. All members voted aye.

3. William Jeffrey Wesley, a student at Casey County High School, is ineligible under By-Law 6, Section 1, Transfer of First Team Competitor. After hearing the facts in this case, the Board did not take action to restore the eligibility of this student.

4. Danny Kilburn, a student at Dilce Combs Memorial High School, will be ineligible after the current semester because of By-Law 5, Section 1, Maximum Number of Semesters. The Board declined to take any action in the case.

5. Vincent Allgeier, a student at Durrett High School, is ineligible under By-Law 6, Section 1, Transfer of First Team Competitor. Following a discussion of information presented, the Board failed to take action to restore this student's eligibility.

6. Paul Smith, a student at Hazard High School, is ineligible for a period of thirty-six school weeks under By-Law 6, Section 1. The Board confirmed action of the previous meeting by refusing to take action to restore this student's eligibility.

Assistant Commissioner Tom Mills reported that due to the inclement weather, the 1973 Foot-

ball Championship Playoffs were not as successful as they had been in the past. Total receipts of the final games were \$30,081.80 with approximately \$9,100.00 in expenses. The expenses did not include the Board grant for incidental expenses.

There was a discussion concerning the amount of money for incidental expenses which should be allotted to each of the six finalists in the football playoffs. Arthur Hawkins moved, seconded by Howard Crittenden, that each finalist in the football playoffs be awarded a grant of \$500.00 for incidental expenses. This is in accordance with Item IV, Section C, of the Rules and Regulations Governing Football Championship. The motion carried unanimously.

Committee Chairman Jack Fultz reported on the meeting of his committee to study the possible changes in the football alignment for the 1974-75 school year. He stated that after much thought and consideration, it was the recommendation of the Committee that no changes be made for the 1974-75 school year, but that further study be given to possible changes for the two year period following the 1974 season. The classifications are set up each time for a two year period and the Committee declined to make changes in the middle of the period. Other members of this Committee are Board members Louie Martin, Jim Williams and Tom Creamer.

Tom Mills then reported that the second State Tournament in Soccer was held in Louisville during the week of November 5 with sixteen teams participating. The tournament was won by St. Xavier for the second year in a row. Total receipts from the tournament were \$1,602.84, with expenses totaling \$1,047.00. Mr. Mills stated that it may be necessary to set up regional tournaments in the very near future if interest in Soccer continues to increase at the present rate.

The next item of business was setting the fee for basketball tournament officials. Commissioner Mansfield recommended the following: \$30.00 for District officials, \$35.00 for Regional officials and \$40.00 for State Tournament officials. In addition to this, officials would be paid 10¢ per mile for travel expenses and \$10.00 should they be required to stay overnight. J. C. Cantrell moved, seconded by Louie Martin, that the recommendation of the Commissioner be approved. The motion was carried unanimously.

Commissioner Mansfield then discussed several items concerning the 1974 State Basketball Tournament with the Board. He explained that the rental fee on Freedom Hall will be \$14,000.00, that WAVE-TV will probably telecast the last two sessions as in the past, and that the teams and cheerleaders will be assigned to stay at various motels in the Louisville area.

The Commissioner read a letter from the Principal of Campbellsville High School, Mr. R. Brooks Bates, requesting that Campbellsville be assigned to another district in football for 1974. The Board

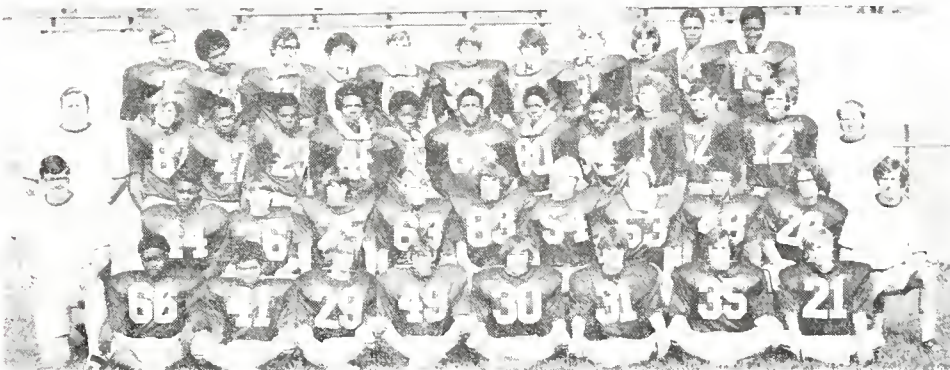

Basketball Tournament Information

The 1974 State High School Basketball Tournament will be held in Freedom Hall, Kentucky Fairgrounds and Exposition Center, Louisville, on March 13-16. The first session of the tournament is scheduled for Wednesday afternoon. There are two sessions for each of the days, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

On or after February 1, 1974, State Tournament Ticket Sales, P. O. Box 7502, Lexington, Kentucky 40502, will accept mail orders for complete sets of tournament tickets. These orders will be filled after the schools have received the tickets allotted to them under the plan of distribution set up by the K.H.S.A.A. Board of Control. The school orders will take all the box seats on the sides, all the chair seats below the boxes and chair seats in the center chair sections.

The prices of tickets per set (8 sessions) are as follows: end box seats, \$32.00; chair seats, \$24.00; bleacher seats, \$16.00. Each order must include a remittance of 25¢ for postage and insurance on the tickets, and checks should be made payable to State Tournament Ticket Sales. Orders for individual session tickets will be accepted during the February 15-28 period, and should not be included with orders for complete sets of tickets mailed prior to that time. Tickets available for individual session tickets will be chair seats at \$3.00 a session and bleacher seats at \$2.00. An over-the-counter sale will begin at Freedom Hall on March 5 and continue through the tournament.

declined to act upon this request inasmuch as the two year classification period has another year before expiration.

Mr. Mansfield then read a letter from Mr. Buford Horton, Superintendent of the Estill County Schools, requesting that the Board reimburse Estill County High School \$500.00, this being the amount he says they lost when the football game between Estill County and Rockcastle County High School was postponed because the officials failed to show up. Mr. Mansfield was instructed to inform Mr. Horton that the Board was in sympathy with him, but that this was simply a mistake on the part of the Assigning Secretary that could not be helped and that the Board had no provisions for honoring a request of this nature. Such a precedent could become disastrous.

The Commissioner then read a letter received from Dr. Guy Potts, Superintendent of the Fayette County Schools, concerning problems in athletics his schools are facing as a result of the energy crisis. The Board discussed the possible effects that continued shortages may bring about in athletics.

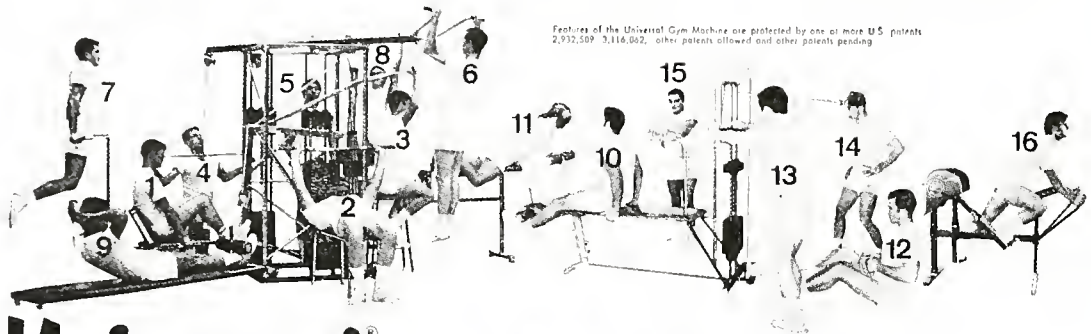

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11. **PLAY:** The official has designated A1 to make a throw-in. (a) A1 makes the throw-in while A2 was standing out-of-bounds at the throw-in spot or; (b) after the ball has been at the disposal of A1, A2 takes the ball and makes the throw-in.

RULING: Violation in both (a) and (b).

COMMENT: The addition to this year's code (9-3-h) covers situations involving throw-ins for which a thrower-in has been designated by the official. The administration as given in the ruling above is in accordance with the new coverage. It is an addition to the previous coverage and applies only to action in close proximity to the throw-in spot and only those situations involving a throw-in. The additional coverage does not in any way affect the previous rulings for Rule 10-A-6(h) and (i). The coverage of Rule 10-A-6(h) and (i) continues to be applicable in situations in which a player leaves the court to confuse opponents, or to avoid a screen, or to evade a defensive player, or for a similar purpose. These infractions, as has traditionally been the case, are penalized with a technical foul. The new coverage in 9-3-(h), is applicable only to throw-in situations. Of course there can be a throw-in situation which is penalized with a technical foul. For example, if a player is unsportsmanlike after the official has designated a thrower-in, or there is a delay, or if players use the situation to deceive the opponents, the penalty is a technical foul.

12. **PLAY:** A1 (7 ft. tall) has one foot on or inside the half of the jumping circle which is far-

thest from his own basket and has his other foot on or outside the restraining circle.

RULING: This is a violation by A1 for not having feet within the restraining circle.

13. **PLAY:** Team A sets up a double screen for A1. A1, in attempting to come across the free throw lane is legally obstructed by offensive and defensive player so that A1 leaves the court under the basket, out of bounds, circles around and returns back into the court and then receives the ball.

RULING: Technical foul is charged to A1 for leaving the court for an unauthorized reason. Whether he receives the ball has no bearing on the decision.

14. **PLAY:** Team A requests a time out prior to the start of the (a) second half or (b) second or fourth quarter.

RULING: The request should be granted in both (a) and (b).

15. **PLAY:** A1 receives a tap from center while both his feet are off the floor. He comes to the floor on one foot in the front court with the ball in his control and he then leaps from one foot and comes to the floor in a stride jump stand with both feet simultaneously in the back court.

RULING: Legal return.

16. **PLAY:** Team A scores a field goal. Team B requests and is granted a charged time-out.

RULING: When the time-out is over, Team B may make the throw-in from anywhere behind the endline. Team B is not required to make the throw-in from a designated spot. The fact that Team B has taken a time-out does not restrict this privilege of throwing in from anywhere behind the endline. The same applies to a time-out after a successful free throw attempt.

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
