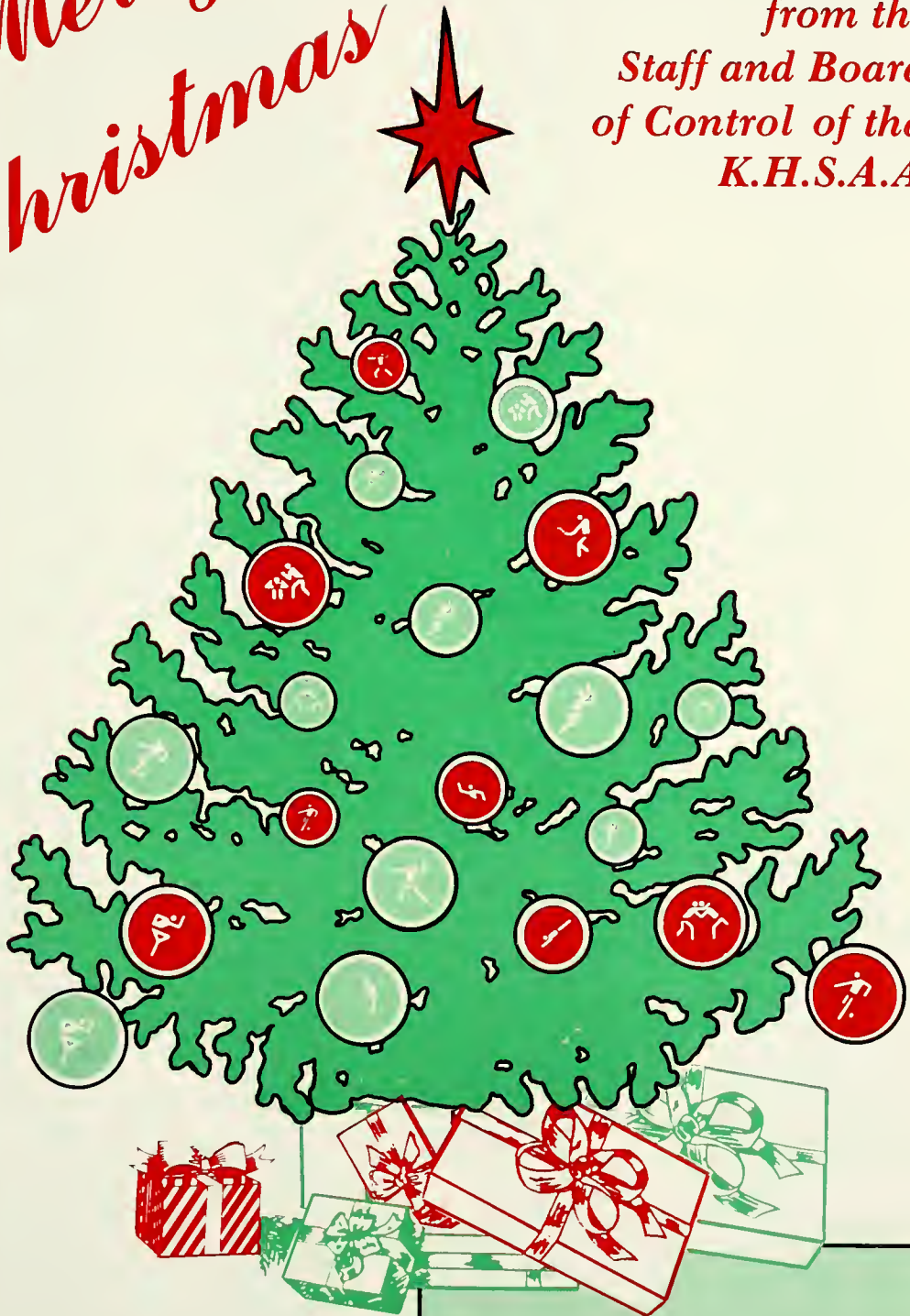

STATE TRACK & FIELD COMMITTEE MEETING

November 22, 1988

The K.H.S.A.A. Track and Field Committee met at the Association Office in Lexington on Tuesday, November 22, 1988. The meeting was called to order by Brigid L. DeVries, Assistant Commissioner at 1:30 P.M.

Members present were: Bro. Borgia, Charlie Ruter, Lyman Brown, Marty Mayer, John Gettler, Rudy McKinney and Bill Patton. Members absent were Jean Wright, Joe Mahan, Ken Trivette, Karen Vanover and Randy Grimes.

Charlie Ruter distributed a Newsletter and reported on the Mason Dixon Games to be held on February 3 & 4, 1989 in Louisville at Broadbent Arena, which is adjacent to Freedom Hall. The Mason Dixon Committee is coordinating efforts with the KTCCCA to help secure more officials for the high school division. The high school division will be open to Kentucky athletes only.

Ms. DeVries then called on Bob Stacey, who was in attendance, to report on KTCCCA activities. He mentioned the addition of more track officials to help at meets as one of the organization's goals.

The first item on the Agenda was a discussion of the Regional and Sectional Track Meets and sites. Committee members discussed and made recommendations regarding Regional and Sectional sites. Ms. DeVries will begin to solicit sites for both the 1989 and 1990 Regional and Sectional Meets. The dates for the 1989 Meets are as follows:

Regional Meets:	May 12 & 13, 1989
Sectional Meets:	May 20, 1989
State Meet:	May 27, 1989

It was noted that the wording regarding scratch deadlines and procedures be detailed further by meet management and highlighted in the Regional Information.

The next item for discussion was the State Track Meet. It was decided that information regarding proper uniform be stressed on the State Information as well as Regional and Sectional Information. The current State Meet format was reviewed, followed by a very lengthy discussion regarding the two-day State Meet proposal, submitted to the Board of Control by Frank Miklavcic.

The proposal was presented to the Board by Reba Woodall at the October Meeting and has been referred to the All-Sports Committee for further study. Committee members were invited to direct comments regarding the proposal to Tom Buchanan and other members of the All-Sports Committee.

The next agenda item was an outline of the expanded Track and Field Clinic program. The dates and exact locations are being secured at this time. People having any good films or audio-visual materials are asked to make them available for use in the clinic program. The area representatives assisting with the track clinics will be invited to the K.H.S.A.A. Office for a meeting regarding the upcoming clinics. Clinic standardization will be stressed. The film *Track and Field The Right Way* was reviewed by the committee, and will be utilized in the clinics this year.

The next item for discussion was the National Federation Rule Changes. For the 1988-89 school year, Points of Emphasis included uniform clarification and safety, especially in the throwing events.

Miscellaneous items included the dates of the 1989 Blue Grass State Games as July 28, 29 & 30.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

THE GAME GUY AWARD

This year the K.H.S.A.A. will again award the Game Guy Award. School representatives and registered officials may make nominations for the award. The eligible person should be a pupil at the junior or senior high school level who has overcome great physical handicap in order to take part in athletics. Letters of recommendation should be addressed to "Game Guy Committee, K.H.S.A.A., P.O. Box 22280, Lexington, Kentucky 40522." Deadline for the 1989 nomination is April 1.

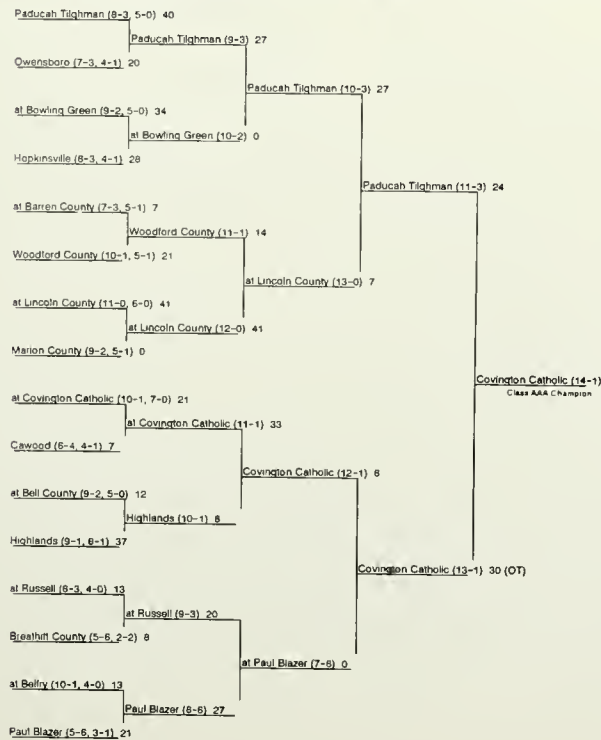

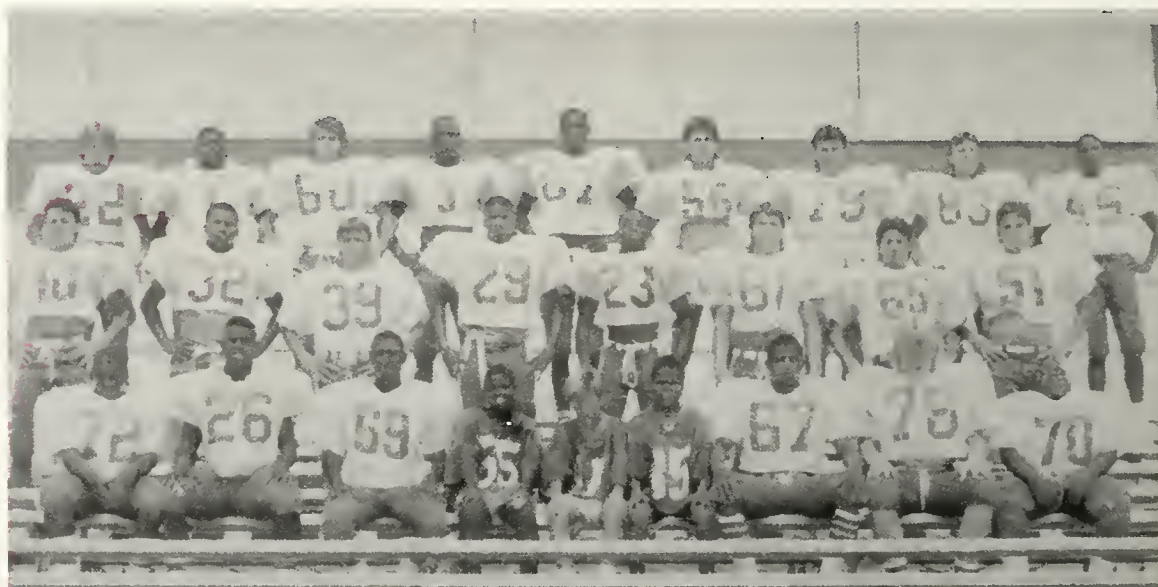

PREGAME PROCEDURE FOR BASKETBALL OFFICIALS

The following guide was adopted at the Assigning Secretaries meeting in basketball, and is to be used in all high school contests this year.

BASIC PRE-GAME PROCEDURE

- 1) Arrival at game site -- a. One hour before game time; b. Report your presence to the Athletic Director; c. Discourage visitation; d. Explain that you need to have a pre-game conference and need privacy.
- 2) Pre Game Conference (Private) -- a. is a must; b. helps insure a smooth running game; c. Referee is responsible for arranging and coordinating
- 3) Topics to cover -- a. Equipment (check whistles, shoes, etc.); b. reaffirm who will be referee and his/her responsibilities; c. Deciding when a goal counts when there is disagreement; d. Knowing the remaining time at end of period; e. The tossed ball to start game and extra periods; f. Notifying or having teams notified before start of game and half; g. handling unruly spectators; h. (1) 3 point play coverage, (2) Injured player procedures, (3) Pressing defense, 4 corner offense, delay offense, no action game, (4) Goal Tending/Basket Interference, (5) Last second shots in close game, who is responsible, (6) Other points as required.

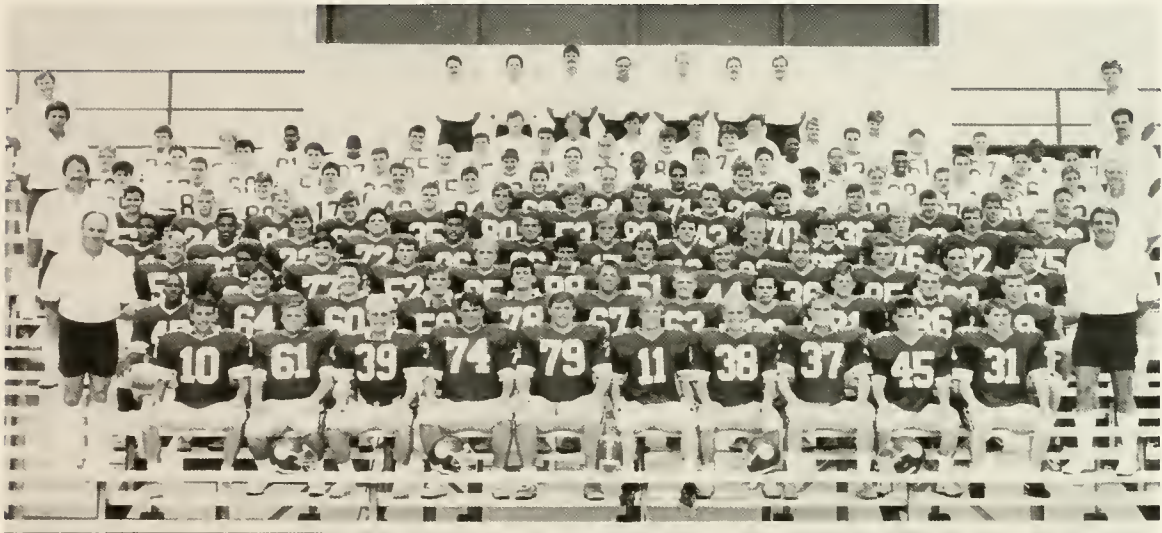
BASIC PRE-GAME MECHANICS

- 1) Arrive on the floor fifteen minutes before the game. Both officials should then meet at table with the scorer and time.
- 2) Both officials should move to the visiting team coach. Introduce yourself and identify the team captains.
- 3) Both officials move to the home team coach. Introduce yourself and identify the team captains. SPEND NO MORE TIME WITH THE COACHES THAN IS NECESSARY TO GET THE CAPTAINS NAMES AND TO INTRODUCE YOURSELVES, CERTAINLY NO MORE THAN ONE MINUTE.
- 4) Move to the table, give the score book a final check, the call the captains to the middle of the floor (10 minutes on clock).
- 5) Captains briefing (10 minutes) prior to starting time. (You may need to adjust this time at the coaches' request.
- 6) Referee move to end of forecourt line on visiting team side and faces warm-up. Umpire moves to forecourt line on home team end and faces warm-up.
- 7) Take in jackets when both teams leave floor. Return immediately to scorer's table. (Jacket, if worn, shall be Navy)
 - 7a. When the team official (R or U) is observing warm up leaves court, the official will go directly to the scorer's table or fellow official.
 - 7b. Strive at all times to be professional.

REMINDER TO SCHOOLS CONCERNING LIMITATION OF SEASONS

All schools are reminded of the Limitation of Seasons Rules, K.H.S.A.A. By-Law 27, as it applies to competition after the conclusion of the regular season. ALL SPORTS are affected by this rule, which states that following the teams' last regular season match, there shall be no further practice or play as a team for the remainder of the school year, with the exception of the K.H.S.A.A. tournament. Please be sure your coaches are aware of this important rule, and that they are not involved in coaching the team in an outside league, or other competition. For the high school coach to coach members of the high team in a league outside of the school, regardless of the type of league, would be a violation of the rules governing the Limitation of Seasons.

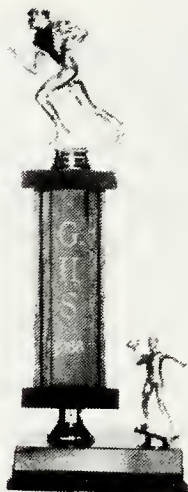
