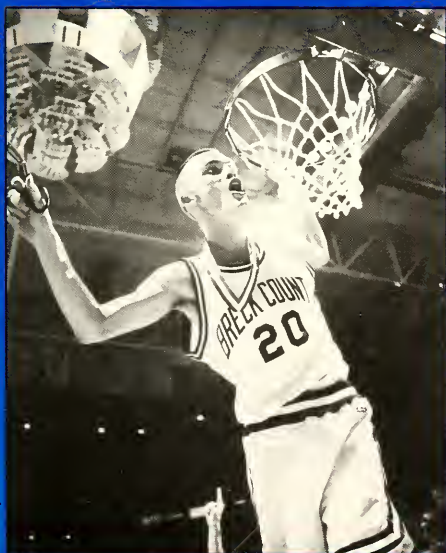

Downing Resigns From KHSAA Post

Brooks Downing, the Kentucky High School Athletic Association's Sports Information Director since 1992, resigned his position on June 23, 1995.

Downing left the KHSAA after accepting a job as the Assistant Media Relations Director for the University of Kentucky. At UK, he will be responsible for all media relations efforts for the men's basketball team.

At the KHSAA, the Lexington native directed all publicity efforts for the Association's 284 member schools while handling media relations for 13 prep sports and all 16 championship events, including the Girls' and Boys' Sweet Sixteen Basketball Tournaments. He also produced and coordinated all championship programs and weekly media releases, as well as numerous other publications and projects produced by the KHSAA.

Prior to joining the Association, Downing, 31, served as a multi-media writer and producer for the legendary

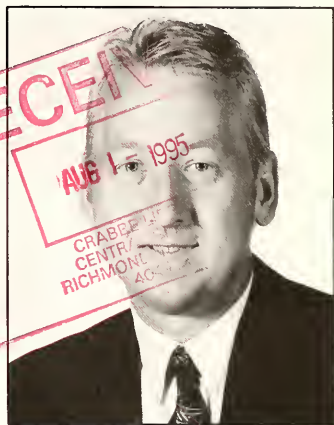
"Voice of the Wildcats," Cawood Ledford. He was also a sportswriter and assistant editor for *Cawood On Kentucky*, a weekly fan magazine dedicated to UK athletics, while serving as an assistant editor for two of Ledford's top-selling books.

He has also served as editor of Kyle Macy's High School Basketball Yearbook and the Minute Mart Scouting Report, a twice-monthly report covering college basketball in Kentucky and Tennessee.

A 1988 graduate of UK in Telecommunications, Downing served a graduate internship in the UK Athletics Department from 1988-90, where he assisted in sports information for all 17 varsity sports.

He has also been a high school and college football official since 1984, and as a member of the Mid South Football Conference, officiated the 1994 NAIA Division I National Championship game.

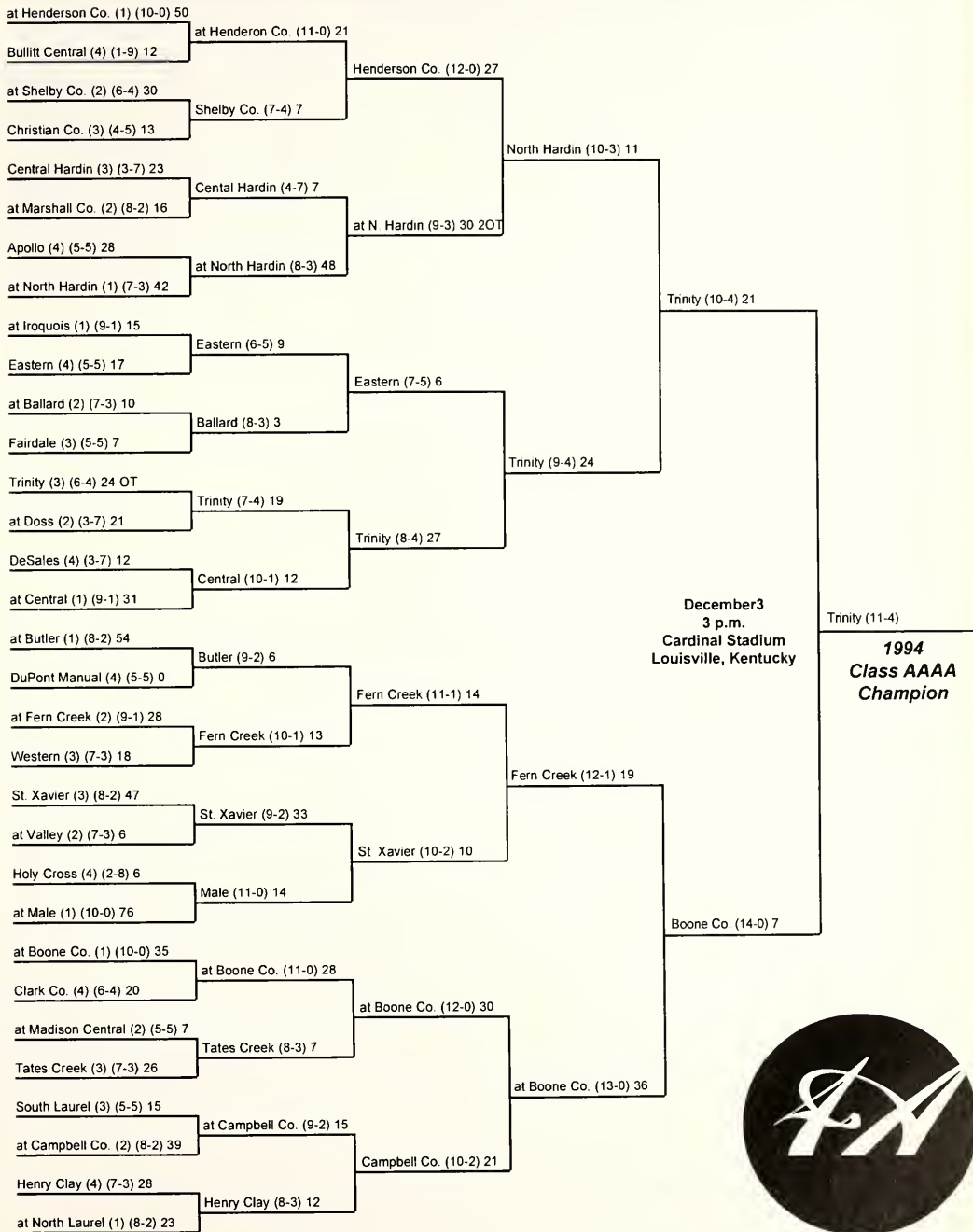

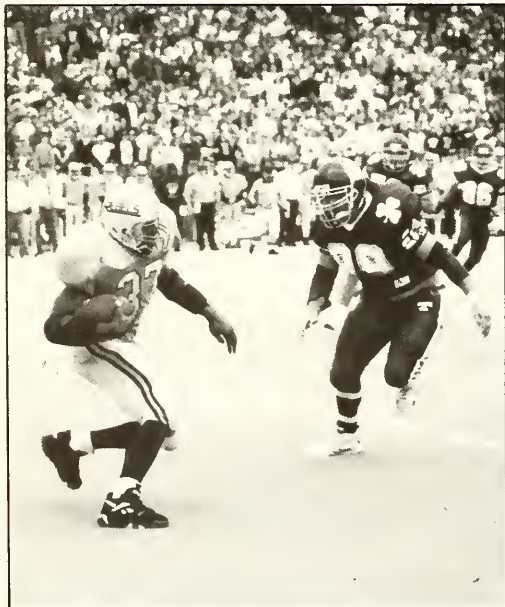

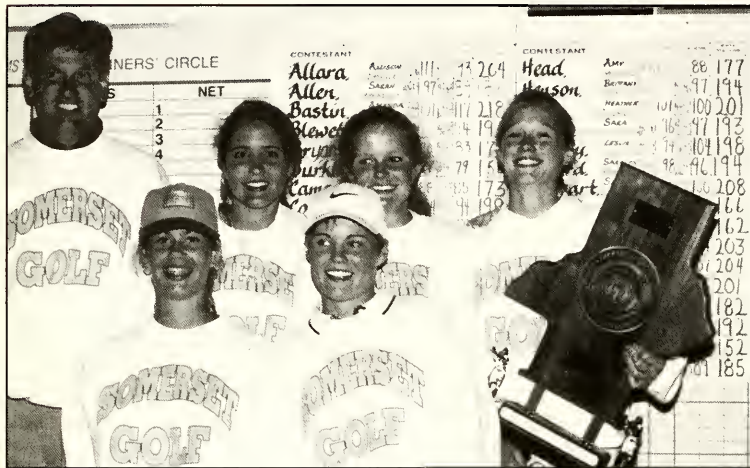
