	Cheap	<i>At minimum expense; of inferior quality or worth; contemptible because of lack of any fine, lofty, or redeeming qualities.</i>
	Cold	<i>Marked by a lack of the warmth of normal human emotion, friendliness, or compassion; not moved to enthusiasm.</i>
	Confident	<i>Full of conviction; having or showing assurance and self-reliance.</i>
	Elegant	<i>Marked by elegance; of a high grade or quality.</i>
	Feminine	<i>Of, relating to, or constituting the gender that ordinarily includes most words or grammatical forms referring to females.</i>
	Friendly	<i>Showing kindly interest and goodwill; not hostile.</i>
	Loud	<i>Marked by intensity or volume of sound.</i>
	Masculine	<i>Of, relating to, or constituting the gender that ordinarily includes most words or grammatical forms referring to males.</i>
	Playful	<i>Full of play; humorous.</i>
	Professional	<i>Exhibiting a courteous, conscientious, and generally businesslike manner in the workplace; participating for gain or livelihood in an activity or field of endeavor often engaged in by amateurs.</i>
	Relaxed	<i>Easy of manner.</i>
	Scholarly	<i>Of, characteristic of, or suitable to learned persons.</i>
	Serious	<i>Thoughtful or subdued in appearance or manner; not joking or trifling : being in earnest.</i>
	Sloppy	<i>Careless; disagreeably effusive.</i>
	Warm	<i>Comfortably established; Marked by or readily showing affection, gratitude, cordiality, or sympathy.</i>
